### Resident Charges Cost of Repairs and Replacements

Due to the variety and scope of replacement and repair items used throughout the facilities, it is impossible to list all items here. Only the most common replacement items are listed. For items not listed, contact the Central Maintenance Office. Except where noted, the labor charge is a standard dollar amount per hour or part thereof and is below the hourly rate and fringe benefits for a Maintenance Mechanic II (See Labor Charges Chart below).

It must be remembered that the charges listed are for <u>damages directly attributed to resident misuse</u>. The financial burden of restoring mistreated property to its "as was" condition must be borne by the party causing the damage. This schedule will not be used to replace "fair wear and tear" items.

Resident damage is best defined as:

- a. Deliberate and/or malicious damage to include breakage and stoppage.
- b. Damage directly caused by improper usage of components.
- c. Damage caused by improper sanitary practices.

LABOR CHARGES WILL BE LEVIED ON ALL ITEMS MARKED "+ LABOR". THIS IS IN ADDITION TO CHARGES SHOWN FOR ACTUAL REPLACEMENT PARTS. IF THE CHARGE SHEET INDICATES "FLAT RATE", THEN LABOR HAS BEEN BUILT IN THE REFLECTED CHARGE.

Reimbursable charges as shown are not resident damage costs but charges for services performed beyond the normal maintenance function.

If the work is contracted and a result of resident damage, the resident will be charged for the actual billing by the contractor.

### **LABOR CHARGES**

Time for computation of labor charges will be based on the work order start and finish time per man utilized with a minimum charge of 30 minutes.

### MOWING OF LAWNS

In developments where the dwelling lease requires the resident to maintain the grounds, work orders to mow residents' lawns will be issued by the Manager after positive determination is made that the resident will not accomplish the mowing. Resident will be charged according to the actual billing submitted by the contractor for all grounds maintenance issues.

### RESIDENT ADJUSTMENTS

Adjustments to heaters, furnaces, stoves, hot water tanks, refrigerators, or plumbing fixtures shall not be attempted by the residents. LMHA has call numbers posted and staff designated to respond to emergency situations, should they arise. A service call to readjust a fixture or appliance will be listed as a resident charge if a case of resident tinkering is apparent. Hourly rate will be charged.

Damage incurred that is beyond the repair capabilities of the maintenance force will be contracted for repair by outside specialists. The prevailing outside wage and material cost will be charged to the resident.
